APP INSTRUCTIONS

Enter your email address and a create a password.

Your email address MUST be the same email address that you provided to your child(ren)'s school in order to connect you with the nessages that have been sent to you.

Make sure the location is set to Canada, Check your email account for a verification message and follow the instructions.

To make sure everything is working properly, click on the three lines in the top left hand comer of the app. The options listed should include Messages, Contacts, Groups, Preferences and Settings. If you do not see the Contacts and Preferences options, your account has not connected properly with our student information. Please contact your school or the Division's Communications Offlicer (780-826-3145) for assistance.

To receive text messages from choolMessenger, text Y to 978-338 to give your consent.

WHAT DOES IT DO?

School Messenger allows schools and teachers to send messages to parents and/or students via voice message to your phone(s), email, or text. Parents can set their preferences and choose which types of messages will be sent through email text, etc

WHAT MESSAGES WILL I GET?

In her work at CASA, she has also provided consultation to Head Start sites and facilitated Circle of Security groups. Prior to coming to CASA, she conducted a range of psychological interventions with children, adolescents, and families presenting with a variety of mental health concerns

Stephanie Parent-Chandler is a Registered Psychologist with a Masters Degree in Counselling Psychology. She has over 10 years of experience within the field of mental health. From 2012 to 2017 Stephanie worked as a Mental Health Therapist rith CASA, providing assessment and treatment services to school age children and their families. She provided individual, group, and family interventions to clients experiencing various concerns. Prior to CASA, Stephanie worked in crisis assessment, intervention, and prevention, responding to individuals experiencing crises related to risk of suicide or violence, and training and mentoring others to provide thorough crisis intervention services.
