


We are currently accepting NEW registrations for Preschool, Kindergarten, and Grades 1-9.




We are happy to accept registrations for the 2019-2020 Kindergarten Program at Iron River School.

# **Register 10044** Kindergarten Q & A Q: How old does my child have to be to start Kindergarten?

**A:** Children must be 4yrs by March 1, 2019 to be eligible for Kindergarten in September 2019.

#### Q: When does Kindergarten start?

A: There will be 2 Orientation/Family Interview Days (Sept.3 & 4). Parents will come in with their child for a short orientation session on one of those days. All Kindergarten students will attend together starting Sept. 5th.

#### Q: How many days a week is Kindergarten?

**A:** 5 days per week (excluding Family Fridays, holidays and other non-school days per calendar)

Q: How do I register my child for Kindergarten?

**A:** Register on-line through the school division website <a href="https://www.nlpsab.ca/parents/">https://www.nlpsab.ca/parents/</a> registration or stop by the school to complete the registration process.

Please have your child's <u>Birth Certificate</u> scanned and ready to upload when registering or bring it to Iron River School to get scanned.

#### WHAT DOES IT DO?

PowerSchool Parent Portal is where parents can view all of their children's information in one place in one account, including grades (for students in Grade 5 and up) and attendance records.

SchoolEngage is part of the PowerSchool Parent Portal, which is where parents can access forms as well as register for Transportation, Out of School Care, Preschool, and K-12.

#### HOW DOES IT WORK?

You must create your PowerSchool account and attach each student to your it. To create this account, you will need an Access ID and Access Password for each child. These are provided by your child's school. If you do not have them, contact the school for more information.

#### WHERE CAN I LEARN MORE?






